- ✓ You are currently in Grades 11
- ✓ You are re-enrolled for Grade 12 and
- ✓ You achieved an average of 79.5% or higher (Honour Roll) based on an average of all cumulative marks on your February report card.

Criteria for choosing a recipient

St. Margaret's is seeking a well-rounded candidate who can demonstrate excellence in:

- ✓ Academic achievement
- ✓ Leadership
- ✓ Service to the community in keeping with the school's motto, *Servite in Caritate*
- ✓ Extra-curricular involvement

Each of the last three may be demonstrated in the school and/or the community.

The successful applicant will be awarded \$5,000 towards her 2010-20111 tuition.

Please submit:

- ✓ A copy of your February report card with this application and
- ✓ A listing of any academic awards and your leadership, service, and extra-curricular activities from the past two years, using the grid attached. You may print additional copies as needed.

Themes to Consider in Preparation for the Written and Oral Evaluations

1. Academic achievements or experiences that have given you the most satisfaction.
2. Volunteer or leadership experiences of which you are proud.
3. How extra-curricular activities have contributed to your personal growth.
4. Looking ahead ten years from now, the person you hope to be and the life you aim to be leading.

Written evaluation

The students will be asked to write on the four themes above. The students' answers to these four questions, in addition to a previously unseen fifth question, will form the basis of the written evaluation process. Students may choose one of the following dates and times for their written evaluation:

Saturday, April 10th 9:30 - 11:00 a.m.

Tuesday, April 13th 3:30 - 5:00 p.m.

Students should arrive 15 minutes prior to these times. No materials, other than writing tools, may be brought into the writing session. Students will be assessed on the form and content of their submissions.

Interview

Finally, each student will be invited to an interview with the selection panel. Students will be asked a variety of questions that are directly related to the criteria listed in *Choosing a Recipient*. The interviews will take place during school hours beginning mid April.

The Award Decision

After reviewing both the written evaluation and interview and evaluating them on the set criteria, the St. Margaret's School Selection Committee will make a final decision on the recipient of the Margaret Barton Scholarship. The winner will be announced at the Closing Ceremonies in June.
