Centennial Scholarship Fact Sheet

St. Margaret's School is pleased to offer the Centennial Scholarship of full tuition fees until graduation for a new day student entering Grade 10.

St. Margaret's School is a community that values diversity and inspires excellence of mind and strength of spirit. We embrace our motto "Service With Love" in both individual pursuits and shared responsibilities.

Who can apply?

New day students entering Grade 10 for September 2011.

What does the scholarship offer?

Full tuition fees until graduation. For Centennial Scholars, the Building Fund is waived. The Scholarship excludes other costs associated with a St. Margaret's education. (*Details of these costs are available from the Admissions Office.*)

What are the criteria for choosing a recipient?

St. Margaret's is seeking a well-rounded candidate who demonstrates excellence in:

- Academic achievement
- Leadership
- Service to the community in keeping with the school's motto *Servite in Caritate*
- Extra-curricular involvement

The selection will be based on all aspects of student life, not focusing exclusively on academic achievement.

In addition, consideration will be given to students who would otherwise be unable to access the advantages of a St. Margaret's School education.

To continue to receive the scholarship in subsequent years, the student must:

- Remain in good academic standing
- Demonstrate involvement in school and/or local community, and
- Adhere to the SMS Code of Conduct, as is expected of all members of the SMS community.

How and when to apply?

Application

Centennial Scholarship forms and the application booklet are available to download online or from the Main Office. Both forms are necessary for a completed application. In addition to the letter of reference from a teacher or administrator at the student's current school, a letter of reference is required from one other professional who knows the student and a \$200 application fee.

Application forms must be fully completed and handed in to the Main Office by **Monday April 11, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.**

Is testing required?

Entrance Exams

Centennial Scholarship applicants sit the normal entrance examinations organized by the Admissions Office. These tests consist of objective exercises in English and Mathematics (CAT 3 tests) and the writing of a given composition.

How is the award decided?

Interview

After reviewing test scores and applications, St. Margaret's School will select applicants for an interview with the Selection Committee in **early May**.

The St. Margaret's School Selection Committee will make a final decision after reviewing both the written evaluation and interview and evaluating them on set criteria.

When is the award presented?

The winner will be announced at the Closing Ceremonies in June.
