Grade Six Scholarship Fact Sheet

St. Margaret's School is pleased to offer an internal scholarship of \$3,000 for a current SMS student entering Grade 7.

Who can apply?

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Currently in Grade 6 at St. Margaret's School
- Re-enrolled for Grade 7
- Achieved an average of B or higher in all subjects on the March report card

What does the scholarship offer?

This scholarship is valued at \$3,000 towards tuition.

What are the criteria for choosing a recipient?

St. Margaret's is seeking a well-rounded candidate who demonstrates excellence in:

- Academic achievement
- Leadership
- Service in keeping with the school's motto *Servite in Caritate*
- Extra-curricular involvement
- Citizenship

The selection will be based on all aspects of student life, not focusing exclusively on academic achievement.

How and when to apply?

Application form

Internal Scholarship application forms will be available to download online or from the Main Office in early February. Each student's completed application will help inform the interview process.

Application forms must be fully completed and handed in to the Main Office by **Monday April 11, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.**

Is testing required?

Applicants will engage in a written evaluation and an interview focused on the four areas outlined in the criteria for choosing a recipient.

Written evaluation

On the Internal Scholarship application form the student is given four themes to consider. The student will be given four questions related to the themes on the application form. Applicants will be given class time to complete this. No materials may be brought into the writing session. Students will be assessed on the content of their submissions, which will be worth 50% of the process.

Interview

Each student will be invited to an interview with the Selection Panel. Students will be asked a variety of questions that are directly related to the criteria listed in *Choosing a Recipient*. The interviews will take place during school hours beginning **in early May**.

How is the award decided?

The St. Margaret's School Selection Committee will make a final decision after reviewing both the written evaluation and interview and evaluating them on set criteria.

When is the award presented?

The winner will be announced at the Closing Ceremonies in June.
