*Due by May 31, 2019 to provide weekly cash allowances of \$40/week (unless otherwise approved by the parent(s) or legal guardian(s)) and to cover incidental costs over and above tuition and boarding (refer to Extra Charges on page 2). Any amount not used will be refunded at the end of the school year or retained for the following school year.

Payment of Fees

Tuition & boarding and supplementary fee payments are **due by May 31, 2019**.

Payment plans are available for BC students, payable in ten (10) monthly installments from July 1, 2019 through to April 1, 2020 and include a 5% finance fee. Payment plans require authorization for either pre-authorized debit (PAD) (requires completion of a [PAD Form](#) available on our website) or credit card recurring payments (requires completion of [Credit Card Authorization Form](#) available on our website).

Bursaries

Extra Charges

Tuition and boarding fees are intended to cover instruction, participation in core school programming, boarding fee and meal plan. The following extra charges may apply on approval by parent(s) or legal guardian(s) and will be charged to student accounts.

School supplies and fees	Exam guides, specialized supplies, extra tutoring, etc.
Miscellaneous	School store purchases, including uniform (\$500 to \$1,000), miscellaneous costs on behalf of student, such as clothing alterations and dry cleaning (\$5-\$70 per item), notarization fees, courier, brokerage charges, etc.
Activities and Outings	Optional house outings, golf camp, instrument rentals, athletic apparel and gear, supplies for recreational activities not covered by School.
Trips and tours	The School undertakes several student trips and athletic tours each year.
Health Centre	Health insurance (mandatory medical coverage for students from outside of BC only, arranged by the School), medical appointments, transportation to/from medical appointments, vaccinations, prescriptions & medical supplies bought by School on behalf of student.

Statement of Accounts

Each month a statement will be created reflecting the status of the student's account, which is due and payable within 30 days. An interest charge of 2% per month will be applied to amounts outstanding 30 days following the statement date. A service charge will be applied for all returned cheques.
